- He has been Deputy Minister of Economy and Finance from 2001 to 2006, Senator of the Republic from 2006 to 2013 and chairman of the Standing Committee of Finance and Treasury of the Senate from 2008 to February 2013.
- As Vice-Minister of Economy, has coordinated and co-founded with the Ministry of Health, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Region of Lazio, the IME, the Institute / Foundation which operates in the Mediterranean care thalassemia through bone marrow transplantation;
- 1988 - 2008: Professor of Economics at the University "La Sapienza" of Rome.
- 1979 - 1988: Professor of Economics at the University of Bologna.
- 1974 - 1978: Professor of Economics at the Catholic University of Milan.

#### **b) Scientific Activities**

- From 1987 to 2001 he was editor of the "Journal of Political Economy" published by SIPI Confindustria, and has been President of the Scientific Committee.
- Editor of "Monographs RPE" series published by SIPI, Rome and of the "Central Issues in Contemporary Economy Theory and Policy" series published by Palgrave / Macmillan, London, and St. Martin's Press, New York.
- His writings are directed to theoretical and empirical analyzes on the subject of the role and impact of the Government budget on the economy both in terms of economic control, structural development, economic growth and income redistribution.
- He also dealt with issues relating to monetary and industrial policies, as well as issues concerning the structure of the labor market and employment.

In his professional career he worked on economic strategies, industrial and financial analysis of the country and the market especially with regard to the north and south America, Africa and Asia, the internationalization of enterprises, analysis and evaluation of investment projects with economic feasibility studies, industrial and financial, strategic planning and management control.
